2.4.	Naming of Teacher Representative to Council <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Kristy Banks and Jane Lefevre will continue to be the teacher representatives on council.</li></ul>
3.	<u>Update from Board Trustee</u>
3.1.	Theresa Kavanagh spoke about the board’s School Learning and Pupil Accommodation Review <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ The board is trying to reduce the number of school transitions for students, and as a result middle schools are being phased out. This also saves money for the board and reduces the number of vacant student spaces</li><li>○ For the Bell High School family of schools, elementary schools would add grade 6, and grades 7 and 8 would be added to Bell High School</li><li>○ Grade 7 and 8 would generally be separated from the grade 9-12 populations, but would have the benefit of the specialized facilities at the high school building</li><li>○ Another grade will not fit at the Lakeview building, but Bells Corners Public School has capacity. The board is proposing that the school populations be switched.</li><li>○ 60-70% of students are bussed at both Lakeview PS and BCPS</li><li>○ 70% of parents choose French immersion for their children, and enrolment is increasing</li><li>○ The board must make the final decision by March 2017. Theresa will continue to provide information as it becomes available.</li><li>○ It is not yet clear what resources would remain in the school buildings, and what resources would follow the students to the new building</li><li>○ More information on the accommodation review can be found on the OCDSB website</li></ul>
4.	<u>Treasurer’s Report</u>
4.1.	Alexandra Wilgosh presented the following update: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Bank balance is \$10,800 in the general chequing and raffle accounts</li><li>○ In 2015-2016, council raised \$35,102 last year, spent \$39,434</li><li>○ Fundraising and spending efforts this year are planned to continue as last year</li><li>○ Discussions with BCPS council would be useful</li></ul>
