- 4.4. Shari met with teachers to discuss the class organization for next year. Unfortunately, enrollment projections indicate that Lakeview will lose one class. Two teachers are indicated to become surplus - Mme Proulx and Mme Kavita. Council was very concerned that student educational support needs in french would not be met.
- 4.5. The projection for next year is for 3 kindergarten classes, at 24 students per class.

5. Leadership Report

- 5.1. The Dance and Bingo night was very well attended, raising \$1,100. Council had agreed to use these funds to purchase ChromeBooks. The cost will be \$384.20 plus HST per Chromebook.

- 5.2. Mayfair update:
 - o For the raffle, all donations need to be confirmed by the end of the week.
 - o Entertainment will be provided by Les Petis Ballets and Arcan TaeKwonDo
 - o Mark Taylor’s office has been contacted regarding the bike parade, and he may be able to facilitate the event.
 - o Kinga B has been contacting community businesses to see if we can acquire sponsorship for some of our larger expenses, such as food.
 - o Julie W has contacted the Shriners to see if they could run our BBQ. They have a large BBQ setup that can feed many people. Coordination of food purchasing would need to be worked out.
 - o Funhaven has donated 150 mystery cards for the mason jar raffle, with values of \$5-\$100 off at Funhaven. Julie W is also working with Value Village to gather mason jar items. Value Village may also accept the leftover items from the book and toy sale.
 - o Julie W suggested having some parent volunteers to run parent vs. kids soccer games outdoors.
 - o Additional potential events include: ring toss and ball toss games; LEGO robotics; birds from last year; student-led nail and face painting.
 - o Theresa suggested contacting SwordPlay (Craig Shackleton) to run a sword workshop. Jen S will contact them.
- 5.3. Julie W reported on behalf of the treasurer. The main bank account currently has a balance of about \$11,000 with upcoming payments of \$2,000 for TACE and \$1,300 for pizza. There is about \$150 in hot lunch payments to deposit, meaning that there is about \$7,850 unallocated.
- 5.4. Discussion was held on the types of funding requests that fall under the TACE program. There was agreement that workshops can be included in these funding requests.
- 5.5. Fundraising update:
 - o Chapters Lakeview Night may be held around Mother’s Day.
 - o A Dance-a-thon could be held during the school day, with classes rotating through 40-minute dance periods. A quiet room could be provided for sensory-sensitive children. Many volunteers would be needed to manage money and pledge forms. A parent lead would be needed to coordinate the event.
 - o A car wash may be held around Father’s Day.
 - o The next coffee order will be run for the end of April.
 - o Lakeview clothing in planned to have an order table at Mayfair.
- 5.6. Family Yoga will be held on April 20 and May 4, 2018.
