Minutes – Discussion & Action Items

- o It would be nice if parents were encouraged to do their holiday shopping at the book fair and to keep the things they buy for either birthday gifts or holiday gifts.
 - o French books needed.
 - o In the past teachers had put their choices of books down as possible teacher presents for their classroom. It would be nice to continue that tradition.
 - o I'm not even sure visiting the fair as a class is a great idea anymore... Perhaps it should just be visited with parents?
 - o More books and less or no toys\pens\impulse purchase stuff
 - o I liked that the prices included tax
 - o Older students to help K\Grade 1 classes. One big kid with two little kids would work
 - o A pre-made wish list sheet
 - o A letter to go to parents with the wish list explaining how to send in money etc...
 - o A little more viewing time per class. It was very rushed.
 - o Consider one of the French book stores like Librarie du Centre
 - o No cash purchases – shop at school and parents buy online.
- 3.2. The Shoestring Opera performance was well received, particularly by younger students and older students interested in performing arts.

4. Treasurer's Report - presented by Heidi W

- 4.1. The lottery account currently has a balance of about \$2,100, and the chequing account has about \$11,940. Pending expenses include: pay out for Scholastic; about \$2,000 in cheques that have been written but have yet to clear. Overall, about \$3,671 is available to be allotted.
- 4.2. Blank cheques have been ordered but have not yet arrived
- 4.3. Teacher Allotment Classroom Enhancement (TACE) funding was discussed. There are 16 staff at Lakeview, and the allotment per teacher will be \$100. Receipts or a spending proposal would need to be submitted by March Break or the unspent funds would be rolled into a pot that would be distributed on a first come, first serve basis.
