Discussion & Action Items
<p>1. <u>Call to Order</u></p> <p>1.1 Aron C called the meeting of the council to order at 6:50 PM on April 20, 2021. The agenda was approved as distributed.</p> <p>1.2 The minutes of the council meeting held on February 9 and March 9, 2021 were not verified and must be approved in May [ACTION].</p>
<p>2. <u>Principal’s Report by Jennifer Capitani:</u></p> <p>2.1 Jennifer C provided her Principal’s Report to the council, highlighting the indefinite move to virtual learning, which began on Monday, April 19. The stay-at-home order has been extended to the middle of May. The school board will update us as they receive information from the provincial government and OPH.</p> <p>2.2 <u>Distribution of technology</u>: Chromebooks and a few internet hotspots have been loaned out. The shift to virtual learning was similar to January’s shift.</p> <p>2.3 The Principal fielded a question regarding whether or not teachers are encouraged to reduce the amount of work. She indicated that curricular expectations stay the same; however, the path which teachers take to deliver learning concepts may be different. She encouraged parents to reach out to the teacher if the workload is too much or with any concerns.</p>
<p>3. <u>Teacher Representative Report:</u></p> <p>3.1 Emily McMenemy provided her Teacher Representative Report to the council, highlighting the shift to on-line learning. The grade six class is graduating and Emily requested some financial support from council to buy t-shirts since fundraising is not possible. The treasurer indicated to reach out to council with an estimate.</p> <p>3.2 Emily fielded a question regarding workload and assessment. She indicated that teachers use professional judgement. There are more expectations of the students compared to this time last year; however, she encouraged parents to reach out to teachers if they have concerns.</p>
