Discussion & Action Items	
1. <u>Call to Order</u> :	<p>1.1. Aron C called the meeting of the council to order at 6:50 PM on October 12, 2021. The agenda was approved as distributed.</p> <p>1.2. The minutes of the council meeting held on May 11 and June 8, 2021 will need to be verified at the next council meeting.</p>
2. <u>Treasurer’s Update</u> :	<p>2.1. Andrea provided an update to the council.</p> <p>2.2. Books have been reconciled and there is approximately \$12 000 in the bank.</p> <p>2.3. The council does not have any outstanding balances owing.</p>

3. Principal's Report:

- 3.1. Principal Capitani provided her report to the council, highlighting that Lakeview has had some turn over of staff. She is working with HR to fill a few vacancies.
- 3.2. COVID-19: LPS had their first positive case a few weeks ago. Principal Capitani is impressed with how the school and community responded. OPH provided communication and it was distributed based on their direction. In general, OPH communicates quickly with high-risk contacts (e.g. in the same class). Most COVID-19 protocols are being continued from last year, with some being more relaxed, such as the use of the gym and sharing books and paper, etc between students.

4. Teachers' Report:

- 4.1. Emily McMenemy provided the Teachers' Report, highlighting that the grade 6 students appreciated the t-shirts (thanked Council for funding).
- 4.2. Students are happy to be back; although many protocols are in place, it feels more normal (e.g. use of equipment).
- 4.3. National Day for Truth and Reconciliation: students looked at TRC in an age-appropriate way.
- 4.4. Welcome night (meet the teacher) is being prepared and is scheduled for Oct. 13.
- 4.5. Terry Fox Run: classes will go out one at a time and run around LPS yard.

5. Business Arising:

- 5.1. Treasurer asked if the money for the t-shirts had come through. Emily to confirm with Kathy Logan **[ACTION]**.
- 5.2. Fundraising: Colleen reminded the council that the gift card fundraiser is on-going. There is a concern about entering banking information online; however, Colleen offered to help with that. Council discussed Purdys Chocolate but no action or decision was taken as council has yet to determine its fundraising goals for the year.

6.1. Discussion/Vote on Council Executive:

6.1.1. **For the position of Chair:** Michael E, having self-nominated and having no opposition, was acclaimed Chair for the 2021/2022 school year; access to chair email account will be granted to Michael E **[ACTION]**.

6.1.2. **For the position of Secretary:** Beth B, having self-nominated and having no opposition, was acclaimed Secretary for the 2021/2022 school year;

6.1.3. **For the position of Treasurer:** Andrea PB, having self-nominated and having no opposition, was acclaimed Treasurer for the 2021/2022 school year. Shantee L will support Andrea in the Treasurer role.

6.1.4. Colleen O will take over the role of website designer from Connie D before the end of the school year. Shantee L will help with communications.

6.2. Discussion re Appropriate Use of Technology Policy: read over the attached policy and give feedback as soon as possible.

7. Open Discussion:

7.1. Some children are feeling disconnected from peers. Is there any attention being paid to this? Response: there has been a strong focus on mental health from the school board; focus on looking for signs that people are struggling. Social workers keep an eye out for isolated kids and families. In staff meetings, staff are discussing how students are doing in terms of wellness.

7.2. Principal Capitani has been told to hold off on school photos.

7.3. Cross-country running and soccer are unlikely to happen this year, given the pandemic restrictions. Principal to confirm with OCDSB **[ACTION]**.

7.4. A member asked if there is a Facebook group. We haven't had one in the past due to the issue of moderation of comments. Principal Capitani communicates all necessary information directly from the school to parents/guardians.
